- Harriet Beecher Stowe describes unhuman conditions of slavery in the book Uncle Tom's Cabin.
- Next significant writer is **Edgar Allan Poe** with his most famous poems The Raven, The Pit nad the pendulum, the Fall of the House of Usher.
- One of the greatest American poets was **Walt Whitman a**nd his work Leaves of the Grass.
- The most important writer of group "Lost Generation" was **Francis Scott Fitzgerald** with the novel The Great Gatsby.
- The best known writers of the first half of the 20th century are Ernest Hemingway and John Steinbeck. Ernest Hemingway belongs to the group of writers called lost generatio,too. He is the autor of a Farawell to Arms, For whom the Bell Talls or short novel The Old Man and the Sea. To the group belongs John Steinbeck. He wrote The

Grapes of Wrath, East of Eden or Of Mice and Men.

The 20th century was full of great writers. For example Joseph Heller and his Catch-22 or Norman Mailer. He is one of the best authors after World War II. His book is called The Naked and the Dead.
