### **Emergency department**

- emergency is a hospital or primary care department specialised in acute care
- its for patients without prior appointment
- must provide treatment for a large spectrum of illnesses and injuries
- there are usually few doctors and nurses, for specialised doctors have to call
- operate 24 hours a day
- in CR you have to pay 90 Crowns first in the reception or in the automat and show the doctor confirmation about the payment or you won't be treated
- order of patients depends on the severity of causes
- you can go there by yourself or by an ambulance car ( old people, people without a car, car accidents, serious injuries)

### **Examples:**

- broken bone ( They have to do a X-ray shot, straighten the bone and fix it by gypsum)



- hard stomach pain ( it can be gastric ulcers-when it pops you can die, appendicitis,...)
- very high temperatures ( sign of inflammation, dangerous for kids)
- heart attack ( pains at left arm, sternum or neck, you cant breathe)
- concussion ( you fell on your head and you have amnesia or headache, vomiting)
