## **Basic information**

- Federal constitutional republic
- 4th largest country after Russia, Canada, China
- The area - million km square
- 50 states + federal district - Washington D.C. (district of Columbia) - the capital, 3,4 mil. Inhabitants, not industrial city, no skyscrapers, most federal institutions such as White house - president Barack Obama
- Liberal democracy
- The Capitol - Congress (2 parts - the Senate, the House of Representatives) or the Pentagon - department of defence
- Hawaii which lies in Pacific Ocean
- Language: american english
- New York - the biggest city
- Currency - U.S. dollar
- „melting pot“ - a lot of cultures and ethnic groups
- Neighbours - Canada, Mexico
- Alaska is separated from the rest of the USA

## **Geography**

- Varied - huge area
- West: Mountainous - Sierra Nevada, the Cordilleras (including Great Canyon)
- Southwest: deserts
- The middle: the plains

- The east: the Appalachian mountains, Atlantic plain
- The lowest extreme: Death Valley
- The highest mountain: Mount McKinley in the Alaska range
- The longest river: Mississippi „father of water“
- Others: Colorado, Rio Grande, Ohio, Niagara, Missouri
- Great lakes (borders with Canada)
- NP: Yellowstone, Rocky mountains, Grand Canyon, Sequoia

## **Symbols**

- Flag: 13 red and white stripes symbolising the original 13 states which used to be the British colonies, first flag created in 1776, on the blue field in the top corner 50 white stars – each star represents one of the 50 states, each stripe r. one of the original state
- Anthem: the Star-Spangled Banner
- The Statue of Liberty – the present from France
- The bald eagle, the rose

## **History**

- 1492 – Christopher Columbus
- 1607 – the first colony in Virginia
- 17th century – colonists (mainly British but also German, French, Italian, Portuguese, Spanish)
- 1775-1783 – the War of Independence
